## **Class Sessions and Times**

All Religious School classes meet weekly, except Post-Confirmation. Early session for Kindergarten-6<sup>th</sup> Grade will be 9:00 a.m.-11:00 a.m. Late session for 5<sup>th</sup> Grade-Confirmation will be 11:15 a.m.-1:15 p.m. Late session priority is given to 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders with older siblings enrolled.

This year, in an attempt to make Hebrew School hours more flexible for our families, we are offering a number of class options.

**Aleph (3<sup>rd</sup> Grade) and Bet (4<sup>th</sup> Grade)** students attend Hebrew School one day a week. Students will have the option of attending Hebrew School on Monday or Tuesday from 4:30 p.m.-6:00 p.m. or on Sunday from 11:15 a.m.-12:45 p.m.

**Gimmel (5<sup>th</sup> Grade) and Dalet (6<sup>th</sup> Grade)** students attend Hebrew School one day a week for class and a separate day for an individual plus hour. **Gimmel (5<sup>th</sup> grade)** will have the option of attending Hebrew School on Monday or Tuesday from 4:30 p.m.-6:00p.m. or on Sunday from 9:15 a.m.-10:45 a.m. In addition, their individual Plus hour will be arranged by the teachers and parents based on their class day, on either Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, or Thursday. **Dalet (6<sup>th</sup> grade)** will continue to have class on Tuesdays from 4:30 p.m.-6:00 p.m. and will have their individual plus hour on Sunday or Thursday.

**Hey (7<sup>th</sup> Grade)** students attend Hebrew School on an optional basis. This is an opportunity for students whose Bar/Bat Mitzvah is later in the school year to continue working on their Hebrew skills. Individual times will be set with the students and their families.

Students will be placed in classes on a first-come, first-served basis in order to prevent overcrowding and balance our classroom numbers. In the event of insufficient enrollment, a class may be cancelled.

In mid-August, you will be notified of the name of each child's teacher and the room number. You will also receive a school calendar. We look forward to working with your family in the year ahead.
