Monday, March 28, 3:30 p.m. via Zoom Virtual Tour of the Monuments Men Exhibit at the Getty Museum in Los Angeles

It's no secret that the Nazis confiscated hundreds of thousands of works of art from Jewish families, collectors, and dealers. It's also a well-known fact that the Allies were responsible for discovering and rescuing many of these precious paintings, sculptures, and decorative art objects. Some passed directly through the hands of the Monuments Men as they were discovered in the salt mines of Austria, in caves, other buildings and even at Herman Goring's summer home. These works were restituted to their owners or their family's heirs via different means including the Allied forces, through governments, and even from museums.
