



Joyce's UH Fitness/Wellness Corner

Bone Health

- 1) The three most important nutrients for bone health in adult-hood are calcium, vitamin D and protein.
- 2) Adults need to do both: a) low impact exercises (ex: swimming, walking, cycling, yoga, chair exercises) and b) resistance training (strengthening major muscle groups with free weights, kettle bells, therabands, or weight machines) to maintain and possibly improve BMD (Bone Mass Density).
- 3) Bone density is the amount of bone mineral in bone tissue.


