In common usage, a mitzvah often means "a good deed"—as in "Do a mitzvah and help Mrs. Goldstein with her packages." This usage is quite old—the Jerusalem Talmud commonly refers to any charitable act as "the mitzvah." The rabbis of the Talmud tell us that there are 613 mitzvot in the Torah. But are these 613 mitzvot, all charitable acts or "good deeds?" As we celebrate Shavuot and the gift of Torah, join us for a discussion of mitzvot and what they mean to us as Jews living in 2023.

# Clergy Message

Late spring and early summer allows us to open so many doors and windows to the world and our own lives. Usually, these mid-months of the year give us wonderful weather, emergent foliage, and a sense of openness that invites us to explore, pursue and relish what our environment has to offer. Though the Festival of Shavuot marks a pause in our Winter / Spring festivals (Tu B'shevat, Purim, Passover and the 49 days of the Omer – including some cultural and Israeli national observances), Shavuot also gives us a sense of transition since those days of preparation, celebration and commemoration occupy so much of our time on top of our daily exploits.

Shavuot is traditionally observed two days when not in Israel. Here, we observe one day as we follow the Israel

traditions of holiday observances. Shavuot reminds us of the Covenant that is contained in the Torah and its importance to us as a cornerstone of our lives. The traditional dairy foods consumed on Shavuot, are symbolic of the nourishment it provides, and the white spaces found in the Torah that inspire us to read deeper into the words. Shavuot is also a celebration of family and welcoming as, in the Book of Ruth, Ruth was one who was embraced by the neo-Jewish people of her time, and she pledged her loyalty to the people.

As we look to this time of seasonal and environmental transition, we hope to celebrate family (however close or extended) and the call to venture out and embrace familiar locales that have brought us good memories while welcoming new friends and experiences. Consider the white clouds that dot the sky, a reminder that the summer opens us up to so many opportunities if we just look up and around. And those same white clouds can represent a klaf of Torah, its black words our foundation and the whiteness, the mystery of revelation and inspiration.

And, when you think of it, stop by UH and just check in. It's always good to touch your past, feel the warmth and life of those inside, or just drive by knowing that we're here for you every season of every year.
