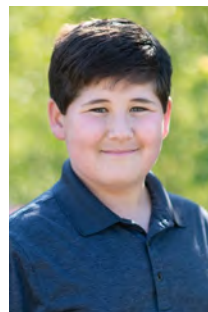

Clergy Message



Rabbi David Reinhart

As we enter July and August, we are in the heart of summer. The sun and warmth brighten our days and, perhaps, our spirits as well. This is a time in which many of us hope to slow down a bit and enjoy the beauty of life. Even so, time continues on, and the calendar, with the Earth, continues to rotate. Of course, the Hebrew Calendar is no exception, and, although many of us “miss” these holidays because we are in summer mode, the Jewish people celebrate a few important moments throughout these two months, including two fast days and the beginning of the month of Elul.

On July 6th, the 17th of Tammuz, we observe the first of these fast days, a minor fast, the Fast of Tammuz, which commemorates, truly, mourns, the Romans breaching the walls of Jerusalem in 70 C.E. Three weeks later, beginning the evening of July 26th, the 9th of Av, we observe Tisha B’Av, which, again, mourns not only the destruction of the Holy Temple in Jerusalem in 70 C.E, but also the destruction of the Temple by the Babylonians in 586 B.C.E. among other catastrophes faced by the Jewish people across the centuries. Apart from Yom Kippur, Tisha B’Av is the most solemn day of the Jewish year and certainly the most somber and sorrowful for Jews around the world, and, like Yom Kippur, it is marked by a major fast, with the recitation of kinot (or elegies) and the reading of Lamentations. Then, on August 18th, we begin the month of Elul, a month of reflection and introspection in preparation for the Yamim Noraim, the Days of Awe – Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur itself.

These days, these periods of somber, solemn, serious attitude and humor (in the sense of mood) may seem out of place at this time of brightness and warmth. They may even feel undesirable in the moment, but the mournful, pensive atmosphere need not cloud the summer sun nor darken our spirits. Indeed, perhaps these moments occur in this season to encourage us to appreciate the beauty of the world all the more. As Psalms 30:12-13 reminds us, “You turn my mourning into dancing, opening my shawl of grief to gird me in joy, all so my whole being might sing to You without end, praise You with gratitude for all time!” This summer may any moments of struggle and darkness only urge us to seek out greater goodness and light, experiencing the joys and beauty of life ever more strongly.

"Jewish law requires that a tombstone be prepared, so that the deceased will not be forgotten and the grave will not be desecrated ... The idea underlying this custom is that the dead will not be forgotten when he is being mourned every day..." -- Jewish Virtual Library

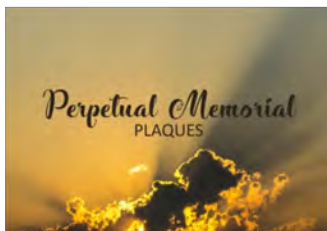
