## Opinion: Violent Antisemitic Rhetoric Begets Violent Antisemitism

This spring, the Jewish Federation of St. Louis released its first community study in a decade. What it revealed was sobering. Across our region, Jews are deeply unsettled by the sharp rise in antisemitism. Most respondents reported changing their behavior out of fear — 28% said they avoid wearing or displaying anything that identifies them as Jewish.



It's 2025 and no one should have to hide who they are. And yet, it's hard to blame our community for being on edge. Just in the past couple of months: a man set fire to the Pennsylvania governor's home while he and his family were sleeping inside; two people were murdered outside an American Jewish Committee event in Washington, D.C.; and a man showed up to a "release the hostages" rally in Colorado armed with a flamethrower and Molotov cocktails.

In all three cases, the attackers claimed their violence was "in support of Palestinians." For Jews around the country it feels like there is a target on our backs. With each incident, we are painfully aware that any one of us could be next.

Let's be clear: The overwhelming majority of pro-Palestinian advocates are not violent. But these terrifying acts are the logical endpoint of a culture that has allowed inflammatory rhetoric, unbalanced and oversimplified narratives, and a disregard for the complexities of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. In this distorted reality, "Zionist" becomes shorthand for villain — and since most Jews identify as Zionists, we, Jews, become the enemy.

We've seen this rhetoric here in St. Louis, too. Not long after the Oct. 7, 2023, start of the Israel-Hamas conflict, an art display at Washington University in St. Louis featured the phrase "Zionism kills."

This hyperbole is meant to negate the fact that Zionism is merely the belief in the Jewish people's right to a state in their historic homeland. Zionism doesn't oppose a Palestinian state, it doesn't endorse any particular Israeli government or policy, and it certainly doesn't justify violence.

Anti-Zionism, on the other hand, isn't about peace. Because anti-Zionism rejects the idea of a Jewish state, it inherently opposes a two-state solution — an idea that, however imperfect, remains the only viable path to peace between Israelis and Palestinians.

To deny Israel the right to exist as a Jewish state within any borders is to reject the principle of a peaceful future. Whether intentionally or not, anti-Zionism lays the groundwork for further division, hatred and violence.

As surveys continue to show that 85% of American Jews support Israel's right to exist as a Jewish state, we've seen extremists target our institutions, our events and our people.

Synagogues and schools now require intense security. That's why a coalition of 46 Jewish organizations is asking the federal government to expand funding for programs protecting the Jewish community. Our U.S. Reps. Wesley Bell, Ann Wagner and Bob Odner, and Missouri Sens. Josh Hawley and Eric Schmitt, must take this seriously and do everything in their power to ensure the safety of the Jewish community.

St. Louisans must also come together to call out the language that dehumanizes Jews and Zionists alike. Slogans like "globalize the Intifada" and "from the river to the sea" are not benign. When they are used as justification for the actions of those committing violence against Jews, these words can no longer be ignored and must be understood as antisemitic calls for violence.

We must stop pretending that words don't matter. They do.

It is time for us to be clear and unflinching in our stand against extremist rhetoric and to demand that those around us do the same. The violence we are seeing today will continue unless we oppose hyperbolic, demonizing, extremist language. By calling out the hateful words of those seeking to tear us apart we can ensure a safer, more secure world.

Let us be brave enough to stand up for what is right and tone down the rhetoric. In a world where words lead to actions, calling out hate can save lives, and help build something better, safer, and more just — for all of us.

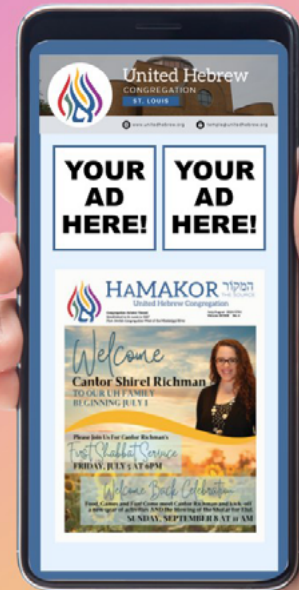
